### VIII. Difficulties Encountered


During the implementation of the activities, the Women Development Cell faced certain challenges, including:


The WDC initiatives contributed positively to holistic student development. Continued collaboration with healthcare professionals, industry experts and public authorities is recommended for future programmes.
