ORDER

Provisional Affiliation was granted for starting a new MBA college viz, Ahalia School of Management (Unaided), Kozhippara, Palakkad (Dt.) during the academic year 2013-14 vide U.O read as 1st and provisional Affiliation was granted to the MBA programme in Health Care Management (additional batch) for the academic year 2017-18 vide U.O. read as 2nd .

2.Continuation of Provisional Affiliation to MBA(30 seats) and MBA in Health Care Management(30 seats) programmes was granted to the college for the AY 2025-26 on conditional basis subject to the submission of renewed NOC from Government for the AY 2025-26 vide U.O read as 3rd .

3. Vide G.O. read as 4th, the Department of Higher Education, Government of Kerala, has renewed the NOC for conducting the MBA programme for the academic year 2025-26.

4. The Principal, vide paper read as 5th, has applied for Continuation of Provisional Affiliation to these programmes for the academic year 2026-27.

5 . All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) has extended its approval to the MBA programme with 60 seats for the academic year 2026-27 vide paper read as 6th .

6. Considering the above, the Vice Chancellor has accorded sanction

(i) to grant Continuation of Provisional Affiliation to the following programmes at Ahalia School of Management, Kozhippara, Palakkad for the academic year 2026-27 on conditional basis subject to the submission of renewal NOC from Govt. for the AY 2026-27:

(ii) to absolutize the U.O read as 3rd, since the College has produced the renewal NOC from the Government for the academic year 2025-26.

7. Orders are issued accordingly with the following terms and conditions:

- Affiliation granted is strictly provisional and only for the academic year 2026-27. The college must apply for CPA for the ensuing years by remitting the fee fixed by University from

time to time, along with the extension of approval orders, if any, from the apex bodies concerned.

- The institution must strictly adhere to the Supreme Court directions (WP (C) 656/1998) regarding ragging prevention; failure to do so will lead to withdrawal of affiliation. Additionally, the college must comply with all conditions stipulated in the renewed NOC from the Government of Kerala for the 2026-27 academic year.
- Admissions for the next academic year shall only be made after obtaining prior permission from the University. No student shall be admitted in anticipation of affiliation, and all selections must strictly follow University/Government rules and regulations.
- All colleges must comply with the relevant regulations & Syllabi. The Principal must ensure that only the syllabi approved by the University and available on the official website (www.uoc.ac.in) are followed.
- To offer a Double Major pathway, the college must ensure sufficient workload. However, if a college wishes to offer a new Double Major programme (not previously sanctioned), it must formally submit applications as per existing regulations.
- The courses sanctioned in this order shall not be used as a basis for calculating subject workload or for claiming additional teaching faculty. Separate competent orders must be obtained from the Government/University for such requirements.
- The conduct of University examinations (including CDOE Examinations) is compulsory and binding. Examinations are only permitted if the college has been granted continuation of provisional affiliation or if their application is currently under process.

Violation of any of the above conditions will lead to the cancellation of affiliation.
